

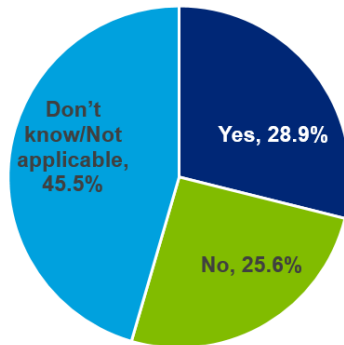

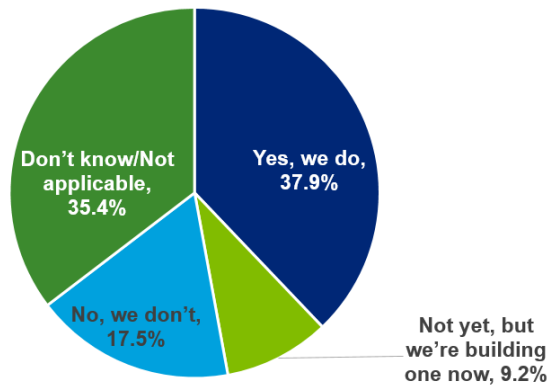
Has your company experienced fraud, waste or abuse in its supply chain during the past 12 months?

Votes Received: 2,596



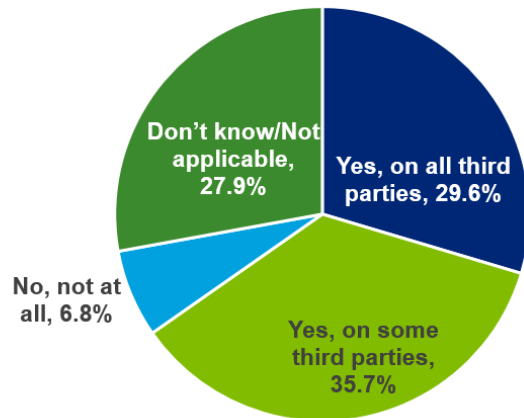
Does your company have a program in place to prevent and detect fraud, waste, and abuse in its supply chain?

Votes Received: 2,564



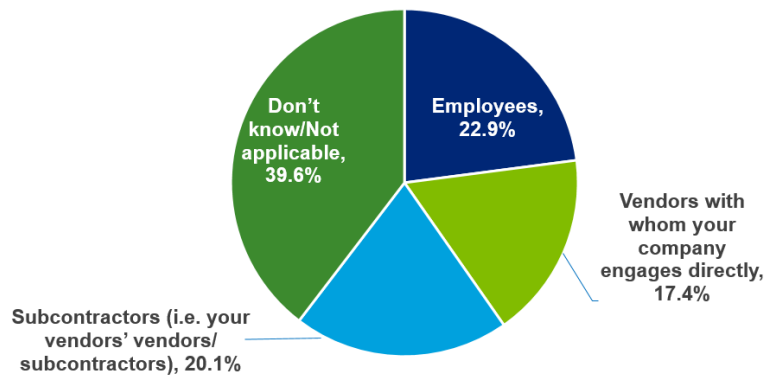
Does your company perform due diligence on vendors and business partners?

Votes Received: 2,587



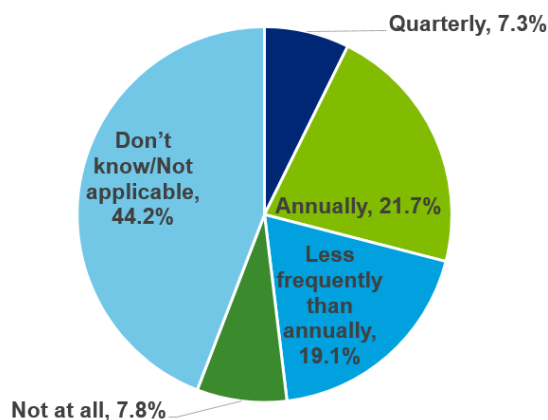
Which group presents the largest supply chain fraud, waste and abuse risk for your organization?
