- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Employee Workplace
- 5 Freedom Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF FINAL RULE.
- 7 (a) Repeal.—The final rule (including any supple-
- 8 ment or revision to such rule) published by the National
- 9 Labor Relations Board in the Federal Register on August
- 10 30, 2011 (76 Fed. Reg. 54006 et seq.), is repealed.

- 1 (b) Rules Requiring NLRA Notices Prohib-
- 2 ITED.—The National Labor Relations Board shall not
- 3 promulgate or enforce any rule that requires employers to
- 4 post notices relating to the National Labor Relations Act
- 5 (29 U.S.C. 151 et seq.) on or after the date of enactment
